



Statistics of Home Care Patients




Encounters of Care With Patients & Families in 2021



Reduced physical visits in Covid-19 pandemic and increased use of telehealth.


Achievements

47.5% of our patients passed on within 30 days. We encourage earlier referrals so that patients will benefit more from our care.

- Loan of Medical Equipment for patients under our care

- Bereavement support in selected cases or referred to professional counsellors
- Public education and advocacy of palliative care
- Training of volunteers, medical/nursing personnel and students


